Coffee Filter Butterflies

Purpose:

This low-key activity promotes creativity! Can be messy!

Space:

Table with a plastic protective table covering (can be messy)

Equipment:

- · 2 large coffee filters
- · Colourful markers
- Pipe cleaner (can use twist ties or string/wool)
- Spray bottle, eye dropper or spoon
- Water
- · Drying surface

Instructions:

- 1. Use two coffee filters and flatten out on top of each other.
- 2. Use the markers to make designs on the filters ensuring that markers leak through both filters.
- Put 2 tbsp water in a spray bottle, eye dropper or use a spoon to spray/drop water on to the colored filter until completely wet.
- 4. Let dry for several hours until completely dry. Once dry, pull apart the coffee filters.
- 5. Fold each filter back and forth like an accordian, in about ½ inch folds, until there are two strips. Ensure they are completely dry.
- 6. Place the two folded filters on top of each other.
- 7. Twist a pipe cleaner around the middle so that the two ends point upwards in a big letter V. You may need to trim the ends. Then pinch the end of each pipe cleaner and curl it outwards to make a spiral for the antennae.
- 8. Hang your butterfly in the window for all to see.
