## **Modeling Clay**

ages: pre-K -Gr. 5

time: 30 min. goal: creative play equipment: kitchen essentials

There are several ways you can make

homemade clay for modeling and arts and crafts projects.

This basic clay is essentially bare-bones cooking dough, which is easy to make with ingredients in your kitchen. It is sufficient for basic modeling projects, but you'll want to throw it out before it starts growing bacteria. All you need to make it is:

- 2 1/2 cups flour
- 1 cup salt
- 1 cup water
- Food coloring (optional)

Mix the clay ingredients together. Store the modeling clay in the refrigerator in a sealed plastic baggie or in a bowl covered with plastic wrap.
